Identity in the Gospel

GALATIANS 2:1-10

Yet because of false brothers secretly brought in who slipped in to spy out our freedom that we have in Christ Jesus, so that they might bring us into slavery— to them we did not yield in submission even for a moment, so that the truth of the gospel might be preserved for you. And from those who seemed to be influential (what they were makes no difference to me; God shows no partiality)—those, I say, who seemed influential added nothing to me. (Galatians 2:4-6)

SERMON NOTES:

Faith in Christ was the means whereby Paul's complete and irreparable break with the law was affected. The Lord Jesus lived under the law, fully obeyed that law, assumed the guilt and penalty which the human race incurred, by having violated the law, and in dying under the law satisfied its requirements. Thus, he passed out of the realm where law in its legalistic aspect had control over him. All believers were identified with Christ in His death and also in His resurrection, and thus have passed out of the realm of divine law so far as its legalistic aspect is concerned.
