

T&T BIBLE QUIZ RULE BOOK

Quizzing will be held at Genesis Church, 1405 Seven Valleys Rd, York, PA



All clubbers in 3rd-6th grade are eligible to compete. Quiz material will be found in:

Agents of Grace (2018 edition)
Discovery of Grace (2019 edition)
Evidence of Grace (2017 edition)
Grace in Action (2020 edition)

A church may register as many clubbers as they like. Quiz is on Saturday, March 23, 2024

Official Rules

REGISTRATION

REGISTRATION DEADLINE: March 11, 2024

REGISTRATION FEE: \$8.00 per clubber for all books.

To register complete registration form

Registration fee must be paid for clubbers to be accepted.

Quiz Format Overview

1. Bible Quiz will be on Units 1 & 2 in Agents of Grace

(2018 edition), Discovery of Grace (2019 edition), Evidence of Grace (2017 edition), and Grace in Action (2020 edition), The Start Zone is also included. Quizzers will be divided into 3rd/4th grade and 5th/6th grade respectively. For example... if a church registers 10 clubbers in Grace in Action and 4 are in 3rd/4th grades and 6 are in 5th/6th grades, they will be split and not competing together.

2. The quiz incorporates the following formats:

Multiple-choice Paddle Quiz

The multiple-choice segment allows participants to perform in a low-key competitive atmosphere. Participants from each book are given an opportunity to answer a series of multiple-choice questions using paddles A-B-C.

Written Quiz

The written quiz segment is a timed segment where participants answer a series of questions. It is held in a room separate from where the rest of the quiz meets.

The coach may accompany clubbers to the written quiz room to make sure they take the correct test. Prior to start of the written quiz, coaches will be dismissed.

The written quiz questions are all multiple choice. Clubbers will choose A,B,C,or D as their answer.

Speed Quiz

In the speed quiz segment, clubbers from each book compete against other clubbers in the same book. There is a series of questions per book. All clubbers will be read the quiz question. The first person to respond is given an opportunity to answer the question.

Cumulative scores from each format are used to determine the winner.

Organization

- 1. The organization of the Bible Quiz meet depends on the number of churches and clubbers participating.
- 2. All clubbers participate as individuals in each book. Each clubber's score will be the result of their individual effort.

Registration

- 1. Clubbers are accepted when registration money is paid. A church may enter an unlimited number of clubbers per book.
- 2. The church may register clubbers for any or all books but is not required to enter clubbers for all books.

General Information

Eligibility

Each clubber must quiz from the handbook they are currently working in. Each clubber may quiz in only one handbook. Each clubber may only quiz one time in a handbook (for instance, a clubber who quizzed in Grace in Action book in one year, could not quiz in Grace in Action again (whether it is the following year or two years).

Apparel

- 1. We emphasize the importance of modesty, neatness and cleanliness in the apparel worn by both leaders and clubbers of all ages.
- 2. All participants (including coaches and staff) must wear your club's official Awana uniform. Shorts are not permitted.

Quiz Questions and Answers

- 1. All questions will be taken from the material in the latest edition of the Awana handbooks (KJV, NKJV, NIV (1984), and ESV). Participants are not expected to interpret the materials.
- 2. Assigned materials will consist of Units 1 and 2 in the current year of Agents of Grace, Discovery of Grace, Evidence of Grace, and Grace in Action. Start Zones ARE also included in the assigned material.
- 3. The event specialist will determine the specific questions to be asked.
- 4. Questions may be asked on any part of the assigned materials, including verses, Bible readings, definitions, etc....
- 5. The quizmaster prefaces each question with the word "question." No talking is allowed from the word "question" until the answer is given.
- 6. Should the quizmaster read a question improperly, the question may be either started over or discarded and a new one selected at the quizmaster's sole discretion.
- 7. All Bible verses MUST be quoted word-perfect according to the latest edition of the Awana handbook. Any translation in which Awana publishes curriculum may be used. If requested, the quotation must include the complete reference.
- 8. No live streaming, audio, video, or written recording of questions is allowed.

9. Pictures are allowed to be taken ONLY when all the quizzers are called up front and seated and prior to any questions being asked.

Use of Handbooks, Bibles, etc.

Once the Bible quizzing has begun, no further studying of handbooks, Bibles or other materials is allowed.

Time-outs

1. The quizmaster is the only official who can declare a time-out.

Coaches

- 1. Each clubber is allowed only one official coach during the quiz meet.
- 2. An individual may coach more than one clubber from their church.
- 3. Coaches may talk to their clubbers while the clubbers rotate between segments of their quiz.

<u>Appeals</u>

- 1. Only the official coach may appeal a question or an answer during the multiple-choice or speed quiz. The coach does this by calling out "question." The immediately preceding question is the only one that may be appealed by the coach. There is no basis for appeal of a written test question.
- 2. All appeals are directed to the quizmaster. When recognized, the coach confers privately with the quizmaster. After the coach voices the question, the coach must return to his or her seat while a decision is being made.
- 3. The quizmaster may consult with the event specialist or judges before making a decision. In all cases, the decision of the quizmaster is final.
- 4. Coaches MUST contest a question immediately after it is read NOT AFTER THE QUIZ!!!

Bible Quiz registration/schedule:

- 1. Clubbers are to be checked in by their coach at the time stated by the event specialist.
- 2. Coaches will submit the names of their quizzers on the registration form and on the quiz roster sheet/score sheet when they check in for the quiz meet. Signed parental consent/release forms must be supplied for all participating quizzers.
- 3. Exact schedule will depend on the number of clubbers/teams registered and will be provided on the day of the Bible Quiz to all coaches and staff.

Rules on the Types of Quiz

Multiple-Choice Paddle Quiz

- 1. For each book, clubbers will be asked a series of multiple-choice questions.
- 2. Questions and possible answers will be read once. There will be three answers to choose from. Quizzers have five seconds to determine their choice of answers. Questions may be read twice if the quizmaster deems it necessary.
- 3. During the reading of the questions, quizzers must look down at their paddles while deciding their answers. Looking any other place may result in disqualification from that question (known as an "eye violation").
- 4. When all answers have been given, the quizmaster will say, "Think about your answer". When the five seconds are up, the quizmaster will say, "Paddles up."
- 5. During the five-second answer time, quizzers select the answer they believe to be correct. Then, at the call "Paddles up," all clubbers will raise the paddle that corresponds to their answer at the same time.
- 6. After the "Paddles up" call has been made, no paddle may be exchanged for another paddle.
- 7. If a participant's paddle is raised late, the participant is disqualified from that question.
- 8. Paddles are to be held up until the command "Paddles Down" is given. At the "Paddles down" command, participants lower their paddles.
- 9. Clubbers & individuals are awarded 10 points for each correct answer.
- 10. A round of multiple-choice quiz will consist of 10 questions.

Sample Questions

- 1. According to Romans 5:8, what did Christ do while we were yet sinners?
- A. Died for us
- B. Died for the ungodly
- C. Entered in the holy place
- 2. Which of the following words is NOT in John 10:28?
- A. Eternal
- B. Undefiled
- C. Perish

Written Quiz

- 1. All clubbers will take an individual written quiz. If a clubber is dyslexic and/or has a reading disability the coach may ask for the quiz to be read to the individual clubber. However, this must be noted on the registration form!
- 2. The written quiz for each book will consist of 20 questions.
- 3. A period of twenty (20) minutes will be allowed for the completion of the written quiz. Pencils will be provided.
- 4. Once the participant has the quiz, there should be no talking, and any handbooks should be in the coach's possession. Any questions should be addressed to the written quizmaster or room monitor
- 5. Participants must not look at another person's paper during the quiz, or they will be disqualified.
- 6. Individuals are awarded 10 points for each correct answer.
- 7. Participants will remain seated until the entire group is dismissed.

Written Quiz Sample Questions

- ____1. According to your handbook, what is the definition of the word "Reconciled"?
- A. To be apart from God forever
- B. Cast judgment on
- C. Have a great reverence or respect for
- D. Changed from enemies to friends with God
- 2. Psalm 147:5 starts with the following words:
- A. I am the Alpha... B. Great is our Lord... C. He is not here... D. May the grace...
- 3. What book of the Bible comes immediately after Judges?
- A. Joshua B. Ezra C. Job D. Proverbs

Speed Quiz

- 1. The number of flights (groups) for speed quiz for each book will be determined by the number of quizzers registered for each book. Any flights not participating in the current round of speed quiz or written quiz will be held in a separate room until their turn to quiz.
- 2. Questions will be read once. Quizzers may press their button to answer as soon as they feel they can correctly answer the question. The entire question does not have to be read.
- 3. If a quizzer buzzes in (responds) before the question is completed, the quizmaster will stop. The clubber must then give a correct, specific answer.
- 4. The clubber has 10 seconds to reach the microphone and begin. They then have 30 more seconds to complete the answer. Grace may be extended for longer answers. However, the quizzer should indicate within 10 seconds if he or she cannot answer, thereby avoiding unnecessary delays and embarrassment.
- 5. We do not allow stalling by saying," My answer is," then stopping. This answer or one like it will not count as starting an answer within the 10 seconds. Any initial answer must be directly related to the question.

- 6. When a speed question has been answered, the quizmaster will ask, "Is that your final answer?" Only when the quizzer answers "yes," or time runs out, will the question be ruled correct or incorrect with "That is a correct answer," or, "I'm sorry, that is an incorrect answer."
- 7. Correct answers are awarded 20 points. Incorrect answers will not result in a points penalty.
- 8. If the first quizzer responding is incorrect, the next quizzer buzzing in will be given the opportunity to answer the question for 20 points. Incorrect answers will not result in a points penalty. The Quizmaster will reread the question to the point where the first clubber buzzed in and then the clubber has five (5) seconds to begin his/her answer.
- 9. If the first quizzer answers incorrectly and there is no second buzz in, the question will be reread as if it were a new question. However, the quizzer who answered incorrectly will be ineligible to answer on the second reading.
- 10. If no quizzer responds in 10 seconds, time is called, and the next question given.
- 11. Questions asked (other than Scripture quotations) may be answered in the participant's own words but must be close to what the handbook states. The judges determine whether anything important to the meaning has been left out or altered.
- 12. If a quiz participant quickly corrects himself or herself in the process of giving their answer, the corrected answer will be accepted.
- 13. Answers that contain extraneous information may be considered incorrect, even if the correct answer is included.
- 14. Help from the audience counts as a wrong answer, even if the answer is correct.
- 15. Any clubber answering three questions correctly "quizzes out" and is awarded an extra 20 points.
- 16. Competitors having two wrong answers in the speed quiz are ineligible to answer additional questions.
- 17. Individual speed questions will not be repeated unless the quizmaster deems it necessary.
- 18. A round of speed quizzing will consist of 12 questions.

Scoring

Scores from all segments are added together to determine the winner. In the event of a tie, the clubber answering the most written test questions correctly will receive 5 points to break the tie. If that does not break the tie, there will then be two winning clubbers.

Quiz Staff

•

- 1. Staffing is at the discretion of the event specialist.
- 2. Each staff member must arrive at the time designated by the event specialist.
- 3. All quiz staff should be in Awana uniform.

Event Specialist

- 1. Makes sure facility and equipment are ready for the quiz.
- 2. Lines up and confirms staff members.
- 3. Lines up clubbers in the given area and sends acceptance to the coaches with information on the Bible Quiz time, place and other information.
- 4. Keeps record of the clubbers registered and checks in each clubber at the quiz meet.
- 5. Conducts coaches and judges meeting on day of meet as necessary.

Quizmaster

- 1. Conducts the quiz program.
- 2. Maintains full authority over the quiz with the event specialist.
- 3. Reads the quiz questions.
- 4. Assists the judges in any decision concerning any contested questions or answers.

Judges for the Multiple-Choice Paddle Quiz

- 1. Check to make sure the quizmaster reads the questions correctly and clearly.
- 2. Assist in any decision concerning any contested questions or answers.
- 3. Judges make the final decision concerning any questions or answers that are appealed.
- 4. Determine if any late paddles are raised or eye violations are committed.

Judges/Monitors for the Individual Written Quiz

- 1. Make sure the tests are laid out and covered prior to the clubbers coming in to take the test.
- 2. Dismiss the coaches prior to the test starting.
- 3. With the help of scorers, grade the tests making sure they are double checked.
- 4. Make sure the tests are given to the Head Scorekeeper.

Head Scorekeeper/Scorekeepers

- 1. Record the points of those clubbers assigned to them throughout the quiz.
- 2. Report their scores to the head scorekeeper.

Scorers for the Written Quiz

- 1. Compare clubber's written answers to the answer sheet.
- 2. Tabulate the clubber's score, giving 10 points for each correct answer.
- 3. Report their scores to the head scorekeeper.

Awards

Participation patches are given to all clubbers who participate in Bible Quizzing.

First, Second, Third and Fourth place awards are given to clubbers in each book. The Quiz Champion Award will be given to any quizzers who attain a perfect score. In addition each clubber has the opportunity to win a bronze, silver, or gold award A bronze award will be given to any clubber, who earns 100-200 points, a silver award will be given to any clubber who earns 200-300 points, and a gold award will be given to any clubber who earns 300-380 points.
